

Council for Licenced Conveyancers latest legal body to recognise Linetime training for CPD awards

As part of this requirement CLC members have to complete 12 hours of Continuous Professional Development (CPD) per year if they are full licence holders such as sole practitioners and 6 hours for limited licence holders i.e. employed licence holders.

Linetime's Managing Director **Tony Klejnow** commented, "Linetime has always promoted the need for customers to invest, not only in the best and most appropriate software solution, but possibly more importantly in high quality staff training.
